

AJ Hackett Cairns Bungy Jump and Minjin Swing



Some persons using a mobility device may need a carer or someone to assist with the steeper sections of pathway leading to AJ Hackett's reception facility.

Welcome to AJ Hackett Cairns

Located in the adventure capital of Australia, the Cairns Bungy Tower was constructed in 1990 and has played host to more than five million visitors. Set in lush tropical rainforest, the Bungy site occupies seven acres of unique land surrounded by pristine world heritage listed rainforest. Natural Australian wildlife also frequent the site with wildlife such as goanna's, snakes, bush turkey's and wallabies, just to name a few. Be sure to check out our wildlife nature signs situated around the natural water features of the site.

AJ Hackett Cairns is one of busiest and most popular bungy sites in the world. Hosting famous Bungy Jumpers like the Red Hot Chili Peppers, Slash from Gun's & Roses, Miss Universe plus many others who have visited over the last 20 years. This site is also very unique as it offers a world first of 16 different jump styles including extreme roof and BMX bike jumps.

AJ Hackett caters to people who use wheelchairs and are very professional in working with people with disability. They are able to assist a person in their wheelchair from the reception level to the top of the jump tower. You will need to talk with staff when booking to let them know the type of chair you may use and level of your disability. They are not able to get electric chairs up the tower due to weight and there may be medical restrictions on some disabilities.

AJ Hackett Bungy is 20 minutes north of Cairns in the middle of the rainforest. With the natural surroundings of the rainforest and waterfalls into the natural flowing pond, the site is considered to be an oasis in the rainforest.

The Bungy tower is 50m tall and is the highest viewing platform in Cairns. From the top you can see out over the Northern Beaches and out to the Great Barrier Reef, so when you're on the edge ready to jump suck in the view as it looks quite different on the rebound!

Parking and drop off at AJ Hackett Cairns

There are no designated accessible parking facilities. On arrival you can be dropped off on the coach area and then the car can be parked on the lower level. As there are no lines marked in the car park on the lower level you can use enough space as required to meet your needs. Alternatively when you book your jump talk to the friendly staff about assistance that you may require.

Entry into AJ Hackett


Entry into AJ Hackett is up a reasonably steep path and assistance will be required by some visitors. Once at reception you will find level access from the reception desk through to the accessible toilet and Gravity Bar.

Accessible Toilets

The accessible toilet is located next to the Gravity bar on the reception level of the facility. The toilet is spacious and well presented.

Weighing In

If you are able to transfer down onto the scales from your chair and don't mind doing so it will make it easier for the crew when rigging your jump if your weight is accurate. If you know your weight and that of your chair ensure you let the crew know.

Getting up the Tower

The staff are very professional and take great pride in ensuring your jump experience is one that you will remember. You can be taken to the top of the tower in your chair providing you are comfortable with being carried in your chair and the chair is capable of being carried safely.



The experience

You will be secured in a full body harness and the team will ensure that you and your chair are secured together in the safest possible way. This harness will also be used if you want to try the Minjin Swing, try it, you won't believe how much fun it is hurtling through the jungle at 120km per hour.

The bungee will be secured to chest point on your body harness and you will always land in the sitting position.

Once through the gate you will experience awesome views, just prior to a blood rush of adrenaline before leaping 50m to the pond below.

Jumping in your chair is an amazing experience and if you are brave, go backwards and see if you can complete a full back flip.
